A. Minutes

Discussion, Consideration & Possible Action on Approval of Committee Minutes from August 21, 2012

Assistant Attorney General, Bridget Harrington, informed the Committee that no action is required as the proper statutes are already in place.

***Opening of the folder**

***Proposed Legislation:**

***A.R.S. §32-501(2)(c)(6)(e)-Adding Threading**

***A.R.S. §32-513(3)-Infection Protection & Law Review Class- Requiring One Class**

Nick Simonetta, Board Lobbyist, informed the Committee that Senator Gowan will sponsor a Bill covering the above statutes. The Bill will be drafted stating that A.R.S. 32-513(3) will have the wording changed to: "Takes and completes a class relating to infection protection and law review that is provided by the board or its designee. The board shall determine the amount of the fee for the class. The applicant shall pay this fee directly to the board or its designee."

MOTION by Gary Begley to recommend approval of the new language to the Board. MOTION SECONDED by Jessica Stall. MOTION CARRIED.

Also under A.R.S. 32-501(2)(b) and also 32-501 (6)(e) the words "and threading" shall be added.

MOTION by Gary Begley to recommend approval of the new language to the Board. MOTION SECONDED by Jessica Stall. MOTION CARRIED.

Mr. Simonetta recommended that any issues regarding eyelash extensions be tabled until a later time.

MOTION by Gary Begley to approve that the eyelash extension issues be dealt with at a later date. MOTION SECONDED by Jessica Stall. MOTION CARRIED.

Gary Begley recommended that the agency keep track of how many cases occur dealing with eyelash extensions.

D. Presentation by Board Lobbyist Nick Simonetta

*** Discussion, Consideration & Possible Action on Recommendations to Board Regarding Educational Programs Designed for Legislators on AZBOC**

***Overview Booklet of Arizona State Board of Cosmetology**

Nick Simonetta explained that an informational and educational booklet be done to show and educate the legislators. He suggested to add letters from representatives in the industry recognizing the advantages of Arizona regulatory actions. Also that a Power Point presentation be made from the booklet which could be used at a health committee informational hearing to really show the impact of the agency's purpose.

Mr. Simonetta announced that he will be watching the changes in the Legislature and any possible changes to Title 32 statutes that may affect the agency.
