Loretta Trippi was sworn in and stated that she though his idea was brilliant when she first heard it students with no debt after completing their education. Loretta Trippi stated that Will Mitchell asked me to sign a non-compete disclosure before speaking to me. Loretta Trippi stated she had her niece come with her to meet with Will Mitchell and asked questions and Will Mitchell said we don't do things like State Board and if students can do a blow-dry before 300 hours we let them that is how we get money and Will Mitchell wanted me to take all of the liability. Loretta Trippi stated that Will Mitchell wanted her niece who has a masters in psychology to train the instructors as counselors so he could bill AACCCS and get money into the school. Loretta Trippi stated that she had asked Will Mitchell why are we doing a commercial when we do not have a school location and Will Mitchell stated that we will find one. Loretta Trippi stated the last time I spoke to Will Mitchell was on June 12th, and asked Will Mitchell to sign a release of the non-compete disclosure and Will Mitchell would not sign.

Investigator Lisa Chavez testified that on September 19, 2019, Board office received information that instructor Loretta Trippi was advertising herself as owner of Sigma C.U.T.S School of Beauty in Queen Creek, Arizona. Loretta is seen on YouTube indicating scholarships are available in Queen

Creek and advertising new cosmetology school and massage therapy school and to apply today at signacut.org. Investigator Lisa Chavez stated that after further review, Board office has not received a new school license for Sigma C.U.T.S School of Beauty in Queen Creek, Arizona and therefore instructor Loretta Trippi was advertising an unlicensed school. Investigator Lisa Chavez stated that party involved in Sigma Cut School of Beauty Corp/World Media Entertainment Inc., are owner including Directors Will Mitchell and instructor Erica Padilla.

Investigator Lisa Chavez stated she found screenshots of Loretta Trippi on YouTube advertising as Owner of Sigma C.U.T.S. School of Beauty and on Facebook a screenshot of Loretta Trippi in a Facebook message claiming ownership of Sigma Cuts.

Investigator Lisa Chavez stated that on November 19, 2019, she called the MOD Pizza and spoke to the General Manager about the fund raisers event for Veterans with P.T.S.D. Investigator Lisa Chavez stated that the proceeds from the fundraiser were sent to Will Mitchell’s address on Pecan Rd.

Investigator Lisa Chavez stated that she contacted the Town of Queen Creek regarding any applications that they might have received regarding “Sigma C.U.T.S. School of Beauty Sigma C.U.T.S. School of Beauty” and speaking with four different departments there is no business license application or pending with that name.

On November 27, 2019, Investigator Lisa Chavez stated that she called respondent and conducted a phone interview, the respondent Loretta Trippi stated that at time she had a questionable affiliation with Blu/Will Mitchell and she and Will were going to start a school together in Queen Creek, Blu/Will Mitchell had her sign a non-compete disclosure, Blu/Will Mitchell wanted her to do a commercial with him, she looked into Will and felt that he was doing things that were not right and she asked Blu/Will Mitchell to be released from non-compete disclosure, which Blu/Will would not do so. Loretta Trippi stated that it turned out that the non-compete disclosure paper was cut in half and wasn’t given to her until after signing. The document has the disclosure expiring in 100 years. Loretta Trippi stated that Will Mitchell had found out that my niece had a psychology degree and wanted her to say the other instructor and herself received training so he could claim and get paid from his insurance. Loretta Trippi stated she had a conversation with Mr. Mitchell about how she would be getting paid for instructing. Will Mitchell told her that a registration charge would be charged to students in the amount of \$2,800.00, I would receive 60% and “Will” 40%. “The registration charge” would be \$1,500.00 kit fee, then later informed no kit but have equipment supplied by school. Students would have to sign a 2 year contract to work in school/salon. School would eventually be turned into salon for students who become licensed and that were contracted for the 2 years. Loretta Trippi stated that things were becoming very fishy and from this point she broke ties with Will Mitchell.
