Kim Scoplitte Executive Director stated that HB2029 and SB1149 both have passed and have been signed by the Governor.

Regarding HB2128 State Licensing; Fee waiver and HB2433 State Agencies; Cash Payment; Acceptance, both bills died with the completion of the legislative session.

4. Review, Discussion, and Possible Action on National Interstate Council (NIC) Nail Technology and Cosmetology Practical Examination Change – Sealed Monomer Requirement.

Alicia Aleman School Liaison stated that the Board received important information regarding changes to the Nail Technology and Cosmetology Practical Examination. Alicia stated that this is in regards to the factory sealed monomer requirement. Due to manufactures' shortages of this product the candidates will be allowed to bring a monomer that is low-odor in its original container with the manufacturer's label without the factory seal.

Alicia Aleman stated that the Board will need to approve a start date to reflect the monomer change that will take place.

MOTION by Gary Begley to accept the idea of having an unsealed container of monomer at the testing site at the earliest possible time and set the date ten days out to allow for this. However if we come across this earlier we would like for the candidate to receive credit the best that they can as the candidate should not be turned away because of this. Executive Director Kim Scoplitte stated that 180 provisional licenses have been issued since June 24, 2021, in response to the PCS scoring issue and the backlog of candidates waiting to take their exam due to the delay caused by the COVID 19 Pandemic. PCS addressed the scoring issue by rescoring the examinations which resulted in many candidates receiving a passing score. Ms. Scoplitte stated that the Board has promptly issued licenses once the Board has received notice of the passing scores.

Gary Begley noted that the Board responded expeditiously and worked with PCS following notice of potential exam issues.

Owner/Licensee Henry Nguyen was present and stated that he can improve and correct this anytime. Mr. Nguyen was not in the salon at the time of the inspection regarding the re-use of the pumice stone so he did not have an explanation but they have already corrected that and stated that pumice stones are not allowed in the salon. Regarding the MMA Mr. Nguyen stated that we use it to practice with and there were no customers in the salon. Mr. Henry stated that they know it is not allowed in the salon. Mr. Nguyen stated the he felt bad and has come here today for any advice and would like the Board to know that everything is legal and that the Board can visit us anytime.

Lisa Chavez Investigator testified that this was a complaint about the salon not following Health and safety standards as well as the owner was allowing individuals to provide services without the proper license. Lisa Chavez stated that she went to the salon on March 22,2021, and spoke to Mr. Nguyen about the complaint and Mr. Nguyen stated that it was not happening. Lisa Chavez informed Mr. Nguyen that an inspection would be conducted and the following was found in the nail salon: Licensee Vinh Quoc Le working with an inactive personal license, licensee Nhat Hang Tran had implements stored with contaminates, clippings and pedicure slippers left on the floor, owner/licensee Henry Nguyen had implements stored with contaminates in two drawers, clippings left on top of station, drill bits not enclosed, three pedicure stations with trash and dust in drawers, three reused pumice stones and one in pedicure station, four pedicure chairs with heavy layer of clippings and trash left on and in crevices, not completely sanitizing the chair, MMA used in the salon. The following was found in the aesthetic salon: Wax stick left in wax pot, reusing wax sticks, trash full of wax strips, wax pot left on.

Lisa Chavez Investigator asked Mr. Nguyen why if the aesthetician hasn't been in the salon for two months was the wax pot left on and Mr. Nguyen stated that his wife was using it and left the mess.

Staff report there is no prior history.
