A. Discussion, Consideration and Possible Action on Approval of Legislative Committee Minutes from September 10, 2015.

Committee Members discussed Hairstyling License, Regulation of Laser, Instructor License and Per Diem Pay for Board Member for possible Proposed Legislation for 2017 Legislative Session and made the following motions.

MOTION by Gray Begley to recommend to the full Board a Hairstyling License with 1000 hours of training and would exclude skin and nails. MOTION SECONDED by Jessica Rainbow. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION by Gary Begley to recommend that the full board affirm its position on the Regulation of Laser and Indirect Supervision of licensees using lasers. MOTION SECONDED by Jessica Rainbow. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION by Gary Begley to inform the Board about the Legislative Study Committee on Lasers required by House Bill 2035 and to ask the Board to affirm its position on the regulation of laser performed for cosmetic purposes. MOTION SECONDED by Jessica Rainbow. MOTIION CARRIED.

MOTION by Gary Begley to recommend to the full Board to issue one instructor license, to reduce the required instructor hours of training to 350 hours and to remove the ability to challenge the Board. MOTION SECONDED by Jessica Rainbow. MOTION CARRIED.

MOTION by Gary Begley to recommend to the full Board to explore a reasonable increase to per diem pay for Board Members. MOTION SECONDED by Jessica Rainbow. MOTION CARRIED.

Committee Members discussed Salon Inspections A.R.S. § 32-542 (A) requires that The board shall inspect all proposed salons to determine if all of the requirements are met. The board may issue a license to a salon pending inspection of the salon as it deems appropriate.

MOTION by Karla Clodfelter to recommend to the full Board to remove the requirement to inspect all proposed salons. MOTION SECONDED by Jessica Rainbow. MOTION CARRIED.

Committee Members discussed School Licenses; Applications; Requirements A.R.S. § 32-551 (B). An incomplete application shall be returned to an applicant within thirty days after the board receives it with the causes for the return.

MOTION by Karla Clodfelter to recommend to the full Board to eliminate this subsection. MOTION SECONDED by Gary Begley. MOTION CARRIED.
