- A. Discussion, Consideration & Possible Action on A.A.C. R4-10-111 (C) to Require Salons and/or Licensees to Post Photos with Personal Licenses and A.A.C. R4-10-107 to Require Applicants for Renewal to Submit Pass Port Quality Photos
- Letter to Governor Requesting Exception to Rule Making Moratorium

A letter was sent to the Governor regarding the agency obtaining an exception to the current moratorium on rule making. An exception may be granted if the action is to protect the health and safety of the public and the letter was written to possibly obtain that exception.

Executive Director, Donna Aune, will call the Governor's office and speak with a contact person regarding the letter to see if the committee or Board needs to do anything further and if there has been any action taken on the request by the Governors' office.

A discussion was held regarding requiring photos to be posted with licenses and the photos could be stamped by the testing agency. The testing company PCS has said they could possibly stamp photos after testing.

Donna Aune, Nanci Kerns, Theresa Bunch and Gloria Ramirez of the agency went to the Motor Vehicle Department this week to look at their photos on driver's licenses system to get a firsthand look at how they process their licenses.

The committee discussed several points:

- The rules already require photos with application
- If renewals required photos then the renewal could not be done online at this time
- If licenses could be issued with photos on them, there would be no need for rule change
