Kim Scoplitte Executive Director stated that each of the Board members have a copy of the letter she received from Trista Guzman Director of Boards and Commissions regarding the guidelines issued by the Arizona Department of Health Services and the Centers for Disease Control relating to business operations for barbers and cosmetologists and the wearing of masks and practicing social distance.

Kim Scoplitte stated that the inspectors and investigators have been and will continue to educate the salons while they are out in the field conducting inspections as well as staff in the office when they receive calls regarding these issues.

Kim Scoplitte Executive Director stated that she contacted Trista Guzman Director of Boards and Commissions on August 6, 2020, regarding Senate Bill 1274 to clarify that any current Board members which have expired will continue to serve on the Board until the Governor has reappointed them as the bill was unclear about this matter.

Trista Guzman emailed back that same day and indicated that the Board members can continue to serve and that they are actively looking at individuals and conducting interviews for all the boards included in SB1274.

Chair Gary Begley stated that we have created some interest in the marketplace and people are wanting to express their position on this and we have several people who are asking to speak and are available to speak during the September board meeting. Gary Begley stated that this was brought up to be looked at and to decide how to deal with this and to report that at the September Board meeting we will have several testimonies from people who are involved parties one way or another and then we can look at this as a Board and make a decision on what we are going to do.

Kim Scoplitte Executive Director stated that the Board's rule writer Jeanne Hann has filed the Notice of Opening Rule Docket and the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking with the Secretary of State for publication in the Arizona Administrative Register. After publication, the Board will take written comment about the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking. An oral proceeding is scheduled regarding the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on September 23, 2020, which will be virtual.

Kim Scoplitte stated that the 5-Year Review Report was submitted to the Governor's Regulatory Review Council and is scheduled to be approved at its October 6, 2020 meeting. However, when GRRC staff deal with time constraints, they sometimes push a 5-Year Review Report to a later meeting. If the 5-Year Review Report remains on the October 6, 2020, agenda, there will be a study session regarding the 5-Year Review Report on September 29, 2020. Both the study session and GRRC meeting will occur virtually.

Carey White was sworn in and represented by her attorney Jennifer Sanders of Slutes Sakrison & Rogers, P.C. who stated that her client seems to be confused and there seems to be two different issues. One is whether or not the student has been provided with a transcript yet she has not as the complainant owes a balance and is consistent with every school and university that I'm aware of. I am a former Assistant Attorney General and I represented the University of Arizona and none of the universities in this state will provide an official transcript to anyone with fees outstanding. So that is why we have not provided the complainant a transcript in the matter. However, we have twice provided her with a computation of her hours, we mailed it to her last known address on November 5, 2019, one day after she had asked for it and she did not disenroll until November 4, 2019, and I would like to note that she filed the complaint on November 1, 2019, prior to making the request to us. Second is the accounting of hours which we provided. The refund computation was signed by her client on company letterhead and my client considered that to be an official document and she was never notified by the complainant that she needed anything other than that. My client proved those two letters to Ms. Chavez on July 16th by email after they were requested. This is not an official transcript of ours but she has received it and my client and all of the schools she is aware of accept those types of documents as computation of hours and once the balance is paid off the official transcript will be sent out.

Investigator Lisa Chavez testified that on November 1, 2019, the board office received an online complaint from student Alayna Lopez alleging that the school is not following the rules and laws of the

Board of Cosmetology. Alayna Lopez requested her own school transcript to enroll in a different school and the request was denied. Alayna Lopez returned to school on October 30, 2019, from a leave of absence and the financial aid representative was not able to complete a new schedule because she did not know how to proceed with the process. Alayna Lopez indicated that she did have some issues with Ms. Saenz on the instructors at the school. Alayna Lopez alleges the vice president of the school Ms. White is refusing to give the student her transcripts.

On February 25, 2020, Investigator Lisa Chavez went the school and spoke to respondent Carey White about the complaint. Lisa Chavez asked Ms. White about the student's transcript and any type of hours given to the student Ms. White stated she was in a refund calculation, while the complainant stated she had not received any of her hours. Ms. White stated that she had resent the complainant's hours and the refund calculation, the refund calculation is not a transcript of any type it just shows how much is owed and indicates the hours of 763.82 however, nothing has been signed off on that paper.

The Malibu C chemist had worked on this for over a week and they could not come up with anything as to the way this reacted this way. Malibu C is vegan, it is an eatable product as it is basically vitamin C.

Investigator Lisa Chavez testified that on November 15, 2019, the board office received an email complaint from Vanessa Lucido alleging that she went to the salon to have her extensions removed and to receive more highlights from Melissa Sawyer. When the stylist determined that the hair might be a little brassy she wanted to do a clarifying treatment, used Malibu C and mixed it in front of the client, applied it to the hair and placed client under the dryer, the hair became somewhat tangled and they both agreed to do another process with the Malibu C. During this time the hair became more matted after that there was two to three days of actively trying to brush out and comb out the product in the hair to take the hair out of the matted state. In Malibu C the active ingredient is a citric acid which could be lemon or orange juice it is not a strong chemical. The complainant stated she did not do anything to make her hair that way and the respondent felt that using Malibu C was something the client needed to remove mineral build up to help with the highlighting process. The complainant went to another salon and had extensions put in and asked the respondent to pay her back for having to get the extensions in the amount of two thousand dollars. Respondent stated that she did everything I could do to help the complainant and was not able to come up with that money or come to an agreement.

Investigator Lisa Chavez stated that the chemical component would not damage the hair.
