AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 32-322, 32-510, 32-511, 32-512 AND 32-512.01, ARIZONA
REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-322, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 32-322. Barber license: application: qualifications:
5 reciprocity

6 A. An applicant for a barber license shall file the following with
7 the board:

- 8 1. A written application on a form prescribed by the board.
- 9 2. Evidence satisfactory to the board that the applicant possesses
10 the necessary qualifications.
- 11 3. One signed photograph.

12 B. Each applicant shall:

- 13 1. Be at least sixteen years of age.
- 14 2. Complete and receive appropriate credits for at least two years
15 of high school education or its equivalent as prescribed by the board in
16 its rules and submit satisfactory evidence that the person is at least
17 sixteen years of age.
- 18 3. Pass an examination given under the direction of the board.
- 19 4. Pay the prescribed fees.

20 5. EITHER:

21 (a) Be a graduate of a school that is licensed pursuant to this
22 chapter or a graduate of a school or program in another state that at the
23 time of the applicant's graduation met the barber licensing requirements
24 of that state.

25 (b) COMPLETE A UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR-APPROVED OR A
26 DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY-APPROVED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM IN
27 BARBERING OR BARBERING APPRENTICESHIP THAT IS OTHERWISE ALLOWED UNDER
28 FEDERAL OR STATE LAW.

29 C. An applicant who holds a valid license to practice barbering
30 issued by another state that has, in the opinion of the board, licensure
31 requirements that are substantially equivalent to the requirements of this
32 state and that grants similar reciprocal privileges to barbers licensed by
33 this state and who has at least one year's experience as a licensed barber
34 is exempt from subsection B, paragraph 3 of this section.

35 D. Notwithstanding subsection B, paragraph 5 of this section, an
36 applicant for a barber license who holds a cosmetologist license or a
37 hairstylist license issued pursuant to chapter 5 of this title shall
38 complete a seven hundred fifty-hour course of study consisting of
39 barbering techniques in a barbering school licensed pursuant to this
40 chapter.

41 Sec. 2. Section 32-510, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
42 read:

43 32-510. Aestheticians: applications: qualifications

44 A person is entitled to receive an aesthetician's license if the
45 person:

1 1. Submits to the board an application for an aesthetician's
2 license on a form supplied by the board.

3 2. Does either of the following:

4 (a) Completes and receives appropriate credits for at least two
5 years of high school education or its equivalent as prescribed by the
6 board in its rules and submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the
7 person is at least sixteen years of age.

8 (b) Submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the person is
9 at least eighteen years of age.

10 3. Submits to the board satisfactory evidence ~~of either~~ THAT THE
11 PERSON MEETS ANY of the following:

12 (a) ~~That the person~~ Is a graduate of an aesthetician school in
13 another state or country that has substantially the same requirements as
14 this state for schools licensed pursuant to this chapter.

15 (b) ~~That the person~~ Is a graduate of an aesthetician course
16 consisting of at least six hundred hours of training in a school licensed
17 pursuant to this chapter.

18 (c) HAS COMPLETED A UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR-APPROVED OR A
19 DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY-APPROVED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM IN
20 AESTHETICS OR AESTHETICS APPRENTICESHIP THAT IS OTHERWISE ALLOWED UNDER
21 FEDERAL OR STATE LAW.

22 4. Passes the examination for an aesthetician's license.

23 5. Pays the prescribed fees for an aesthetician's license.

24 Sec. 3. Section 32-511, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
25 read:

26 32-511. Cosmetologists; applications; qualifications

27 A person is entitled to receive a cosmetologist license if the
28 person:

29 1. Submits to the board an application for a cosmetologist license
30 on a form supplied by the board.

31 2. Does either of the following:

32 (a) Completes and receives appropriate credits for at least two
33 years of high school education or its equivalent as prescribed by the
34 board in its rules and submits satisfactory evidence that the person is at
35 least sixteen years of age.

36 (b) Submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the person is
37 at least eighteen years of age.

38 3. Submits to the board satisfactory evidence ~~of either~~ THAT THE
39 PERSON MEETS ANY of the following:

40 (a) ~~That the person~~ Is a graduate of a cosmetology course
41 consisting of at least sixteen hundred hours of training in a school
42 licensed pursuant to this chapter.

43 (b) ~~That the person~~ Is a graduate of a cosmetology school in

9 Sec. 4. Section 32-512, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
10 read:

11 32-512. Nail technicians; applications; qualifications

12 A person is entitled to receive a license to practice nail
13 technology if the person does all of the following:

14 1. Submits to the board an application for a nail technician
15 license on a form supplied by the board.

16 2. Does either of the following:

17 (a) Completes and receives appropriate credits for at least two
18 years of high school education or its equivalent as prescribed by the
19 board in its rules and submits satisfactory evidence that the person is at
20 least sixteen years of age.

21 (b) Submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the person is
22 at least eighteen years of age.

23 3. Submits to the board satisfactory evidence ~~of either~~ THAT THE
24 PERSON MEETS ANY of the following:

25 (a) ~~That the person~~ Graduated from a nail technology school in
26 another state or country that had at the time of the person's graduation
27 substantially the same requirements as this state for schools licensed
28 pursuant to this chapter.

41 A person is entitled to receive a license to practice hairstyling if
42 the person does all of the following:

43 1. Submits to the board an application for a hairstylist license on
44 a form supplied by the board.

- 1 2. Either:
- 2 (a) Completes and receives appropriate credits for at least two
- 3 years of high school education or its equivalent as prescribed by the
- 4 board in its rules and submits satisfactory evidence that the person is at
- 5 least sixteen years of age.
- 6 (b) Submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the person is
- 7 at least eighteen years of age.
- 8 3. Submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the person
- 9 ~~either~~ MEETS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 (a) Graduated from a hairstyling school in another state or country
- 11 that had at the time of the person's graduation substantially the same
- 12 requirements as this state for schools licensed pursuant to this chapter.
- 13 (b) Completed a hairstylist course consisting of at least one
- 14 thousand hours of training in a school licensed pursuant to this chapter.
- 15 (c) COMPLETED A UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR-APPROVED OR A
- 16 DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY-APPROVED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM IN
- 17 HAIRSTYLING OR HAIRSTYLING APPRENTICESHIP THAT IS OTHERWISE ALLOWED UNDER
- 18 FEDERAL OR STATE LAW.
